

sheet, to record your findings - a trowel - soft paint brush - black crayon or charcole stick - paper to make rubbings (cheap shelf paper works great). Put the above mentioned tools in a box in the trunk of your car and you are ready to check out a cemetery at the drop of a tombstone.

BE SURE you are searching in the right County. Check the date the County was formed against your family dates. You may find your ancestor is in another County. The original Counties have been divided and sub-divided so BE SURE OF YOUR DATES!

Example:
BUTLER County, KY formed 1803 from Livingston Co.
LIVINGSTON county formed 1798 from Christian Co.
CHRISTIAN county formed 1797 from Logan Co.
LOGAN county formed 1792 from Lincoln Co.
LINCOLN county formed 1780 from Kentucky Co. VA.

Never use a stiff brush to clean a tombstone, they are old and crumbly. If the paint brush does not remove the dust and dirt, make a rubbing. Old tombstones settle with age, if part of the inscription is below ground level, gently ease the sod away with the trowel. The crayon or charcole stick and the shelf paper are for making rubbings. Aurora, August 3, 1853

Mr. Taylor

Sir In answer to your letter I will state that my name was EMILY GRANGER before my marriage to TINO KENT - that I was sixty three years old last February - that I was married to Tino Kent in Suffick, Connecticut August 30, 1810 and that he died March 27, 1837 - That I was married to SAMUEL RUSSEL Sept. 4, 1839 and that he died June the 8th 1853 - I was married to Samuel Russel in Aurora Portage County Ohio and that both my said husbands died in this last mentioned place.
