Jms* in the regiment of *2^d Ohio vols* that he enlisted on the *Twenty Sixth* day of *September* for the term of *War with Mexico* and was discharged at *Cincinnati Ohio* on the *Twenty fifth* day of *July* by reason of *Expiration of term of service*

KNOW YE, That *Alonzo Kent* a *Corporal* of Captain *Wm H Sytle's* Company [A] 2^d Regiment of *Ohio* Volunteers, who was enrolled on the *26th* day of *September*, one thousand eight hundred and *47* to serve DURING THE WAR WITH MEXICO, is hereby HONORABLY DISCHARGED from the service of the United States, this *25th* day of *July* 1848, at *Cincinnati* by reason of being mustered out of the service on the expiration of his term.

Said *Alonzo Kent* was born in *Europe* in the State of *Ohio* is *23* years of age, *5* feet *8* inches high, *Fair* complexion, *light* eyes, *light* hair, and by occupation, when enlisted, a *Carpenter* GIVEN at *Cincinnati* this *25* day of *July* 1848.
