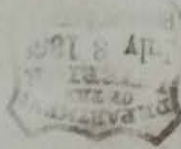

1. Claimant's name.
2. Soldier's name.
3. Here specify the service as follows: "in the company commanded by Captain _____ in the _____ regiment of _____ commanded by _____ on board of the United States ship _____" or "as the case may be."
4. Enlisted, volunteered, was drafted, or shipped.
5. Add: "that she has never before made application for Bounty Land," or "that she made application for Bounty Land for said service, and her claim was rejected, or suspended."
6. The claimant will here state that no public or private record of her marriage exists, or can be obtained, if such is the case. If there is a County, Town, or Church record of the marriage, a duly certified copy of such record must be sent. If there is no public, but a private or family record containing the marriage or the birth of children, a copy of such record must be sent, and the magistrate will certify that it is a correct copy of the original. Parol evidence of the marriage or of co-habitation, is not admissible until the absence of record evidence is accounted for. If the testimony of persons who were present at the marriage can be produced, it should be sent, and if such testimony can not be had, the Claimant will so state. This form will not alone be sufficient for the claim, without amendment or additional evidence of the marriage, unless the declarant is unable to present either public or private record evidence or the testimony of persons who were present, and so states in her declaration.
7. The witnesses will here mention facts and circumstances which induce their knowledge or belief that the husband of the Claimant was the soldier named, that he is dead and that the Claimant is now a widow. The mere statement of witnesses that their knowledge is derived from "personal acquaintances," or a similar statement, is inadmissible.

10. Magistrate's signature. The affidavits can be made before a Justice of the Peace, or any other officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes.
