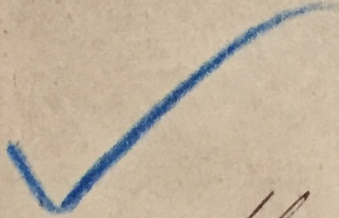

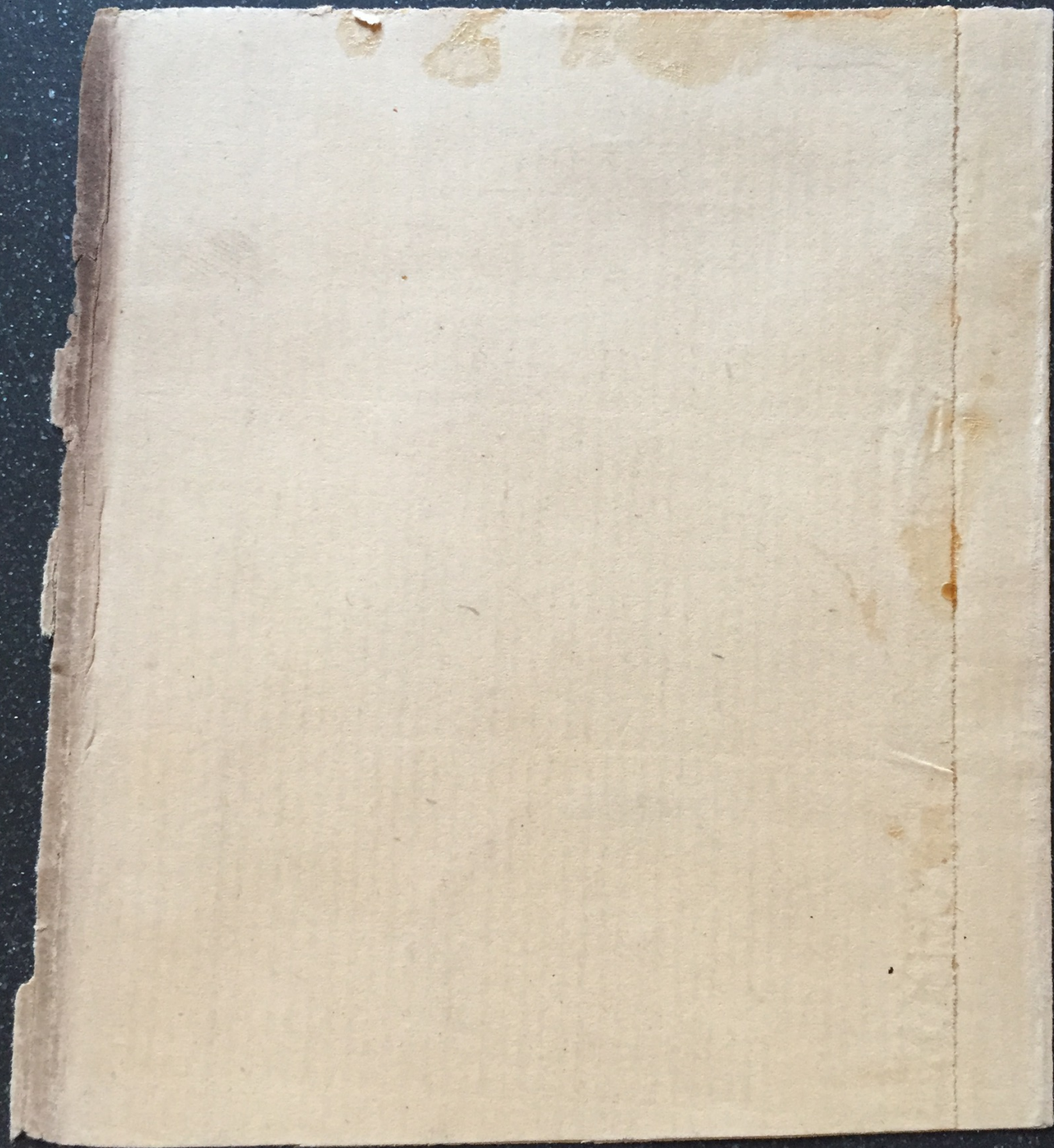

was a private in the company command-  
ed by Captain Shimei Mann in the Georgia  
regiment of Infantry commanded by Colonel  
Jett Thomas in the war with Great-Britain  
declared by the United States on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of  
June 1812, for the term of six months and  
continued in actual service in said war  
for fourteen days; that he has heretofore  
made application for bounty land under the  
act of September 28<sup>th</sup> 1850 and received a  
Land Warrant No not-recollected for eight  
ty acres, which he has since legally disposed  
of and cannot now return

He makes this declaration for the purpose of  
obtaining the additional bounty-land to  
which he may be entitled under the act approved  
the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1855. He also declares that  
he has never applied for nor received under this  
or any other act of Congress any bounty-land  
warrant except the one above mentioned.

One thousand eight hundred and fifty one personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid Charles Kent aged Seventy two years a resident of Pike County in the State of Georgia who being duly sworn according to law declares that he is the identical Charles Kent who was a private in the Company commanded by Captain Shimai Mann in the Regiment of Malatia commanded by Colonel Jett Thomas in the war with Great Britain declared by the United States on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1812 that he was drafted in the County of Oglethorpe in said State of Georgia and entered said service on or about the Eighth day of October A.D. 1814 for the term of six months and continued in actual service in said war for the term of a little over five months and was honorably discharged at Sparta in the State of Georgia on or about the tenth day of March A.D. 1815 that he received a written <sup>certificate of</sup> discharge but that since receiving said discharge he has had a trunk stolen which contained said discharge and that he has never seen it since but believes that said service will appear by reference to the muster rolls of said Company

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the Act granting bounty lands to Certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military Service of the United States, passed September the 28<sup>th</sup> 1850

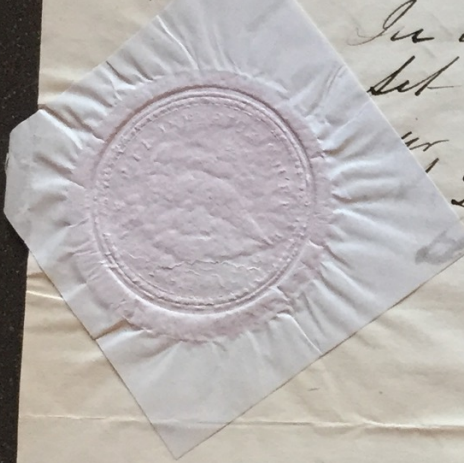
