BOUNTY LAND CLAIM.

STATE OF Ohio COUNTY OF Franklin SS.

On this 26th day of June A. D. 1851, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the county and State aforesaid, Columbus

Grant aged 55 years—a resident of Franklin Co in the State of Ohio

who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Columbus Grant who was a private

in the company commanded by Captain John Lasay in the 9th Superior Militia Regiment of Superior Militia commanded by Colonel Rindall in the war with Eng-

land in 1812-13 & 14 one John Johnston who was great substitute for at Fluorena Co Va on or about the 2nd day of November A. D. 1814 for the term of Three Months and continued in actual service in said war for the term of one Two Months and was honorably discharged, at Norfolk Va on or about the 10th day of Sept A. D. 1815 as will appear by the muster Roll his discharge being lost

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the act passed September 28th, 1850.
