TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN.

KNOW YE, That *Ebenezer Kent* a *Private* of Captain *Peter Chadwick's* Company *Thirty* regiment of *Infantry* who was enlisted the *Twenty fifth* day of *June* eighteen hundred and *Twelve* to serve during the war, is hereby honorably discharged from the army of the United States, having faithfully served out the full period of his enlistment.

Said *Ebenezer Kent* was born in the *Town of Durham* in the *State* of *New Hampshire* is about *Forty* years of age, *Five* feet *Seven* inches high *Light* complexion, *Blue* eyes, *Dark* hair, and by occupation, when enlisted, a *Farmer*
