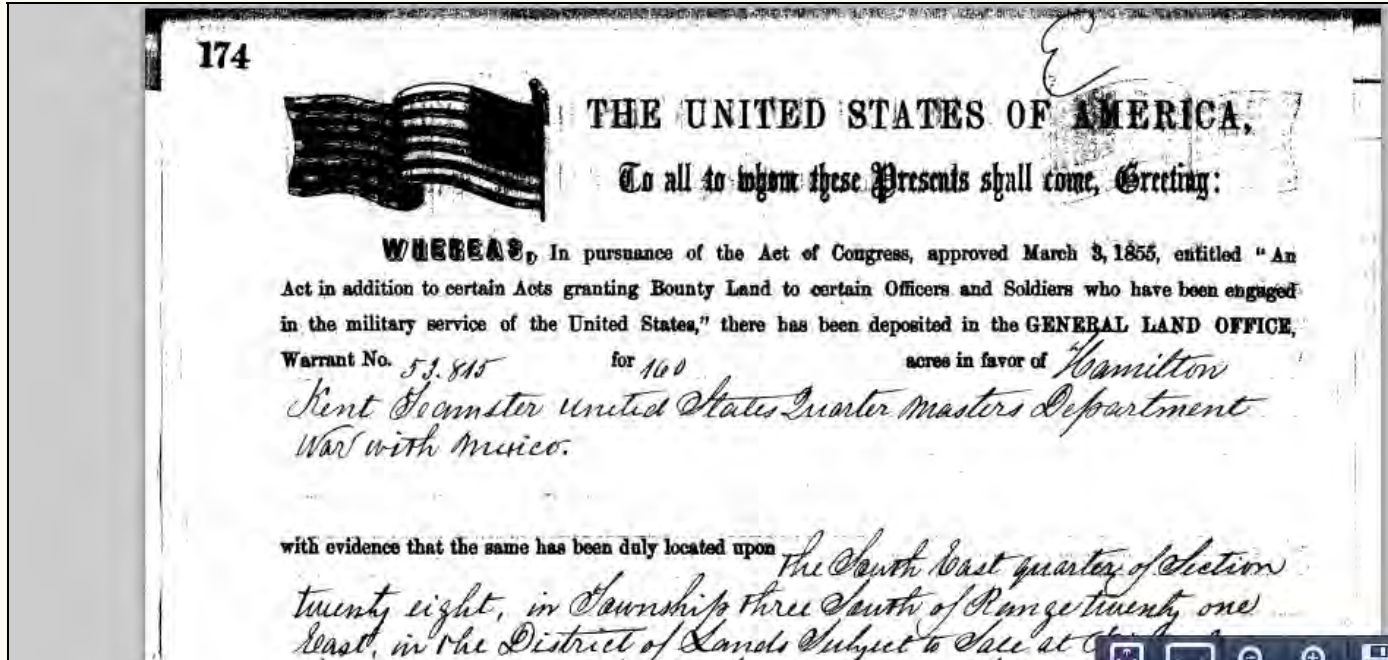

AFFIDAVIT REQUIRED OF PRE-EMPTION CLAIMANT.

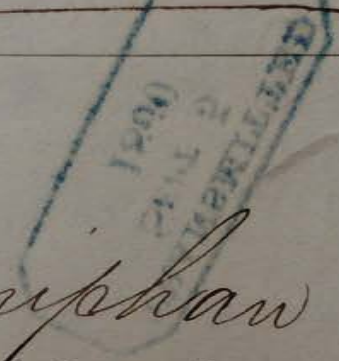
