- On 23 April 1855, Harvin Kent was age 63 (born about 1792) and a resident of Spalding Co., Georgia.
- He was a Private in the Georgia Militia, Second Regiment, under Capt. S. Mann and Col. J. Thomas in the War of 1812.
- He was drafted at Oglethorpe, Georgia about 01 October 1814.
- He signed his name with a signature.

On this 6<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty on personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Harvin Kent aged 89 years, a resident of Pike Co in the State of Georgia, who being duly sworn according to law, declares, that he is the identical Harvin Kent who was a Private in the 2<sup>d</sup> Regiment of Militia commanded by Col. Thomas in the war with Great Britain and the United States in June 1812 in Georgia that he was in the 2<sup>d</sup> Regiment of Militia on or about the 11<sup>th</sup> of October A. D. 1814 for the term of Six months and continued in actual service in said war for the term of upwards of five months and was honorably discharged at August 30<sup>th</sup> from the 11<sup>th</sup> of March A. D. 1815 as will appear by his original certificate of discharge herewith presented, or by the muster rolls of said Company. as he never had any written discharge

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the "act granting bounty land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," passed September 28th, 1850.

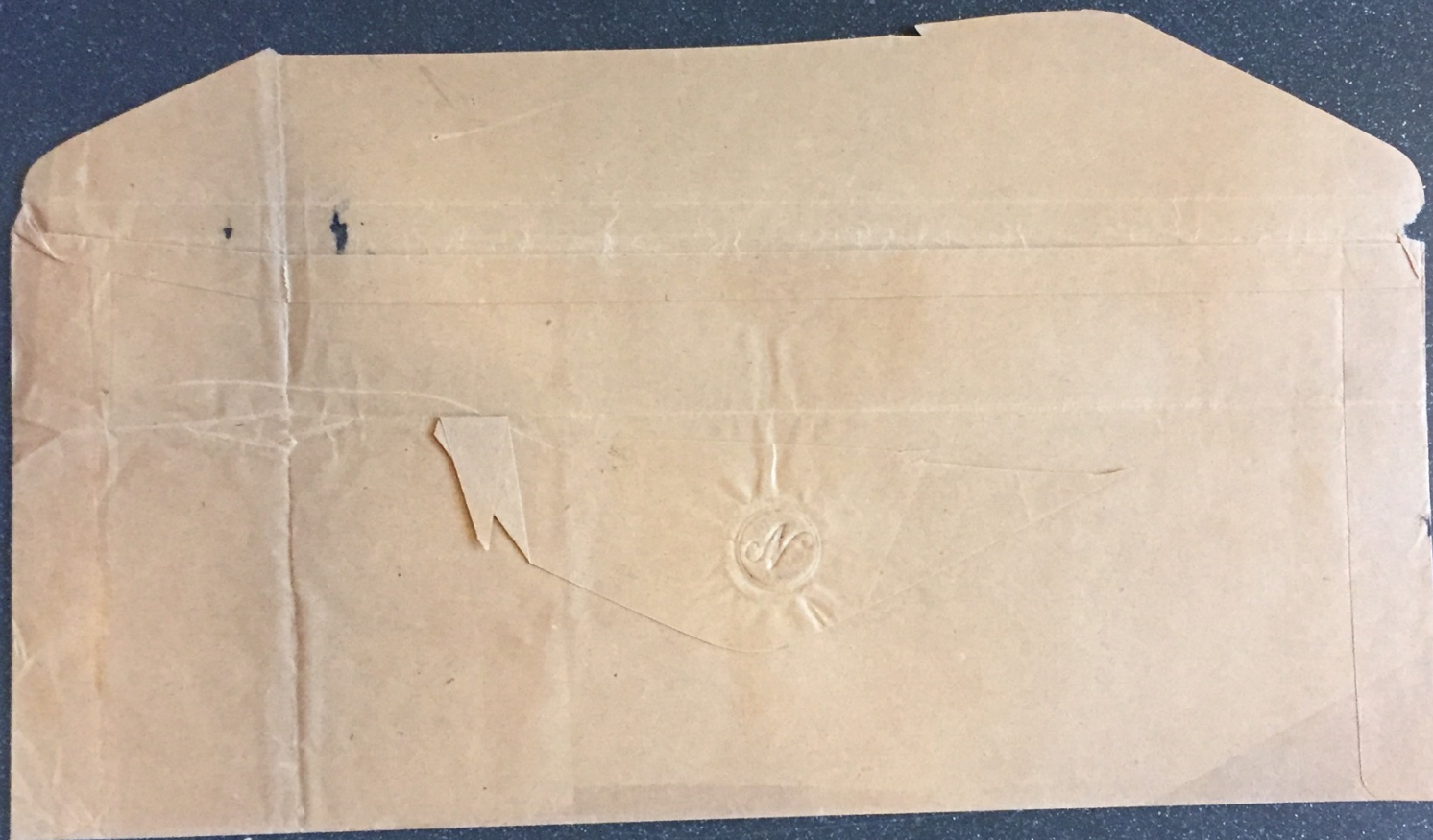

On this *twenty third* day of *April* A. D., one thousand eight hundred and fifty *five* personally appeared before me *David H. Johnson* a *Justice of the Peace* duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the *County* and State aforesaid *Harvin Kent* aged *Sixty three* years, a resident of *Said County* in the State of *Georgia* who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical *Harvin Kent* who was a *private* in the Company commanded by Captain *Shimi Mann* in the *Georgia* Regiment of *Drafted Infantry* commanded by *Col J. H. Thomas* in the War *with Great Britain* that he *entered the Service* at *Spalding County* on or about the *1st day* of *October* A. D., *1814* and continued in actual service in said War for the term of *Six months* and was honorably discharged at *Spauld Georgia* on the *14th day* of *March* A. D. *1815* on account of *Peace being declared between the United States & Great Britain* as will appear by the muster rolls of said Company.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the Bounty Land to which he may be entitled under the "Act granting additional Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," approved March 3, 1855. And refers to his former declaration made under Act of *September 28 1850* upon which he obtained a Land Warrant No. *(forgotten)* for *Eighty Acres* acres, which he having legally transferred and disposed of, is not within his power now to return.  
He further declares that he has not received a Warrant for Bounty Land under any other Act of Congress, nor made any application therefor, than the one above referred to, under Act of *September 28 - 1850* upon which he obtained the said Land Warrant, No. *(forgotten)* for *Eighty* Acres, and the one now presented *Harvin Kent* Seal

Sworn to and subscribed before me the day and year above written ; and I hereby certify that I believe the said *Harvin Kent* who signed and executed the above declaration, and is now present, to be the identical man who served as aforesaid, and that he is of the age above stated, and that I have no interest in said claim. *Ephraim Lynch* J. 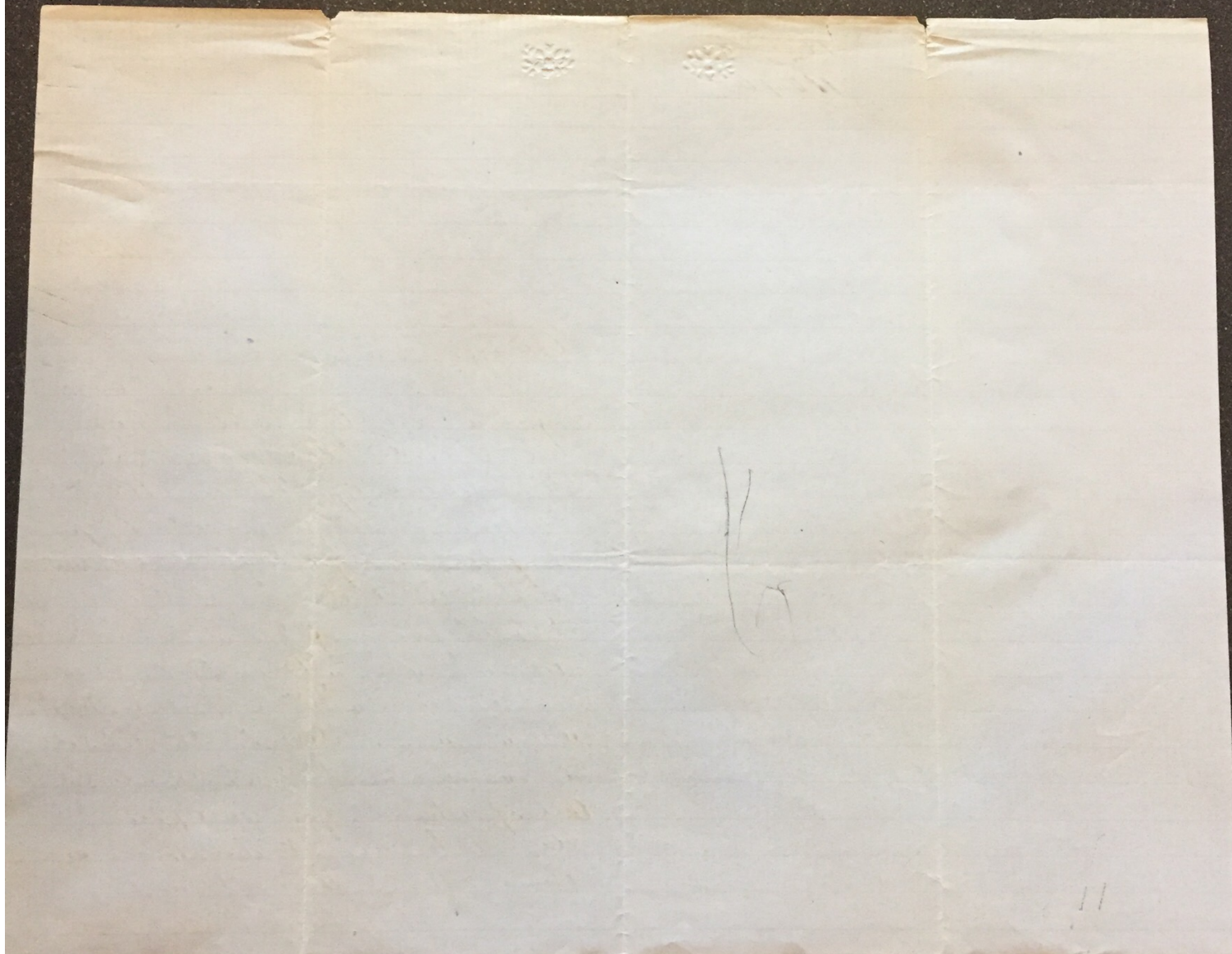

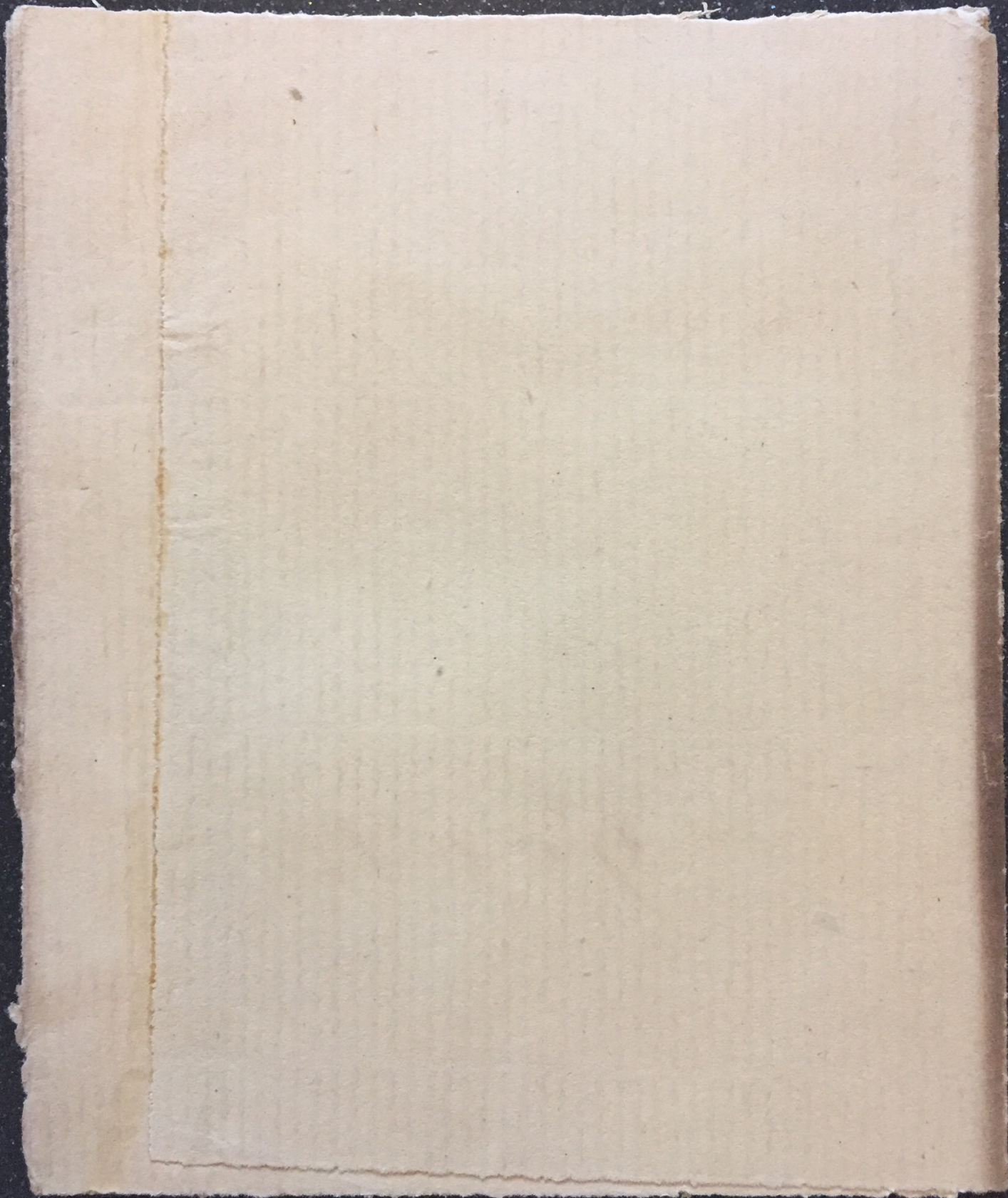
