- On 08 January 1851, Harvin W. Kent was age 37 (born about 1814) and was a resident of Muscogee Co., Georgia.
- On 19 May 1855, Harvin W. Kent was age 41 (born about 1814) and was a resident of Chattahoochee Co., Georgia.
- He served during the Creek War of 1836.
- He served voluntarily in March 1836 at Columbus, GA as a substitute in Georgia Militia's Infantry under the command of Captain Joseph Coleman, under Colonel R. Hardaman.
- He signed his name with his mark.

On this the 19th day of May A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty five personally appeared before me, a ^{clerk of the} ~~Superior Court~~ Harven W. Kent within and for the County and State aforesaid, aged forty one years, a resident of Chattoahoochee county in the State of Georgia who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Harven W. Kent who was a private in the company commanded by Captain Coleman in the Georgia Militia commanded by Colonel R. W. Harbarnum in the war with Creek Indians in eighteen hundred and thirty six that he was substitute at Columbus Georgia on or about the latter part of March A. D. 1836 for the term of ~~two months~~ ^{three months} and continued in actual service in said war for the term of ~~fourteen days~~ ^{eighteen hundred and fifty}; that he has heretofore made application for bounty land under the act of ~~Eighty~~ ^{Eighty} acres, which he has since legally disposed of, and cannot now return.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the additional bounty land to which he may be entitled under the act approved March 3, 1855. He also declares that he has never applied for nor received, under this or any other act of Congress, any bounty land warrant except the one above mentioned.

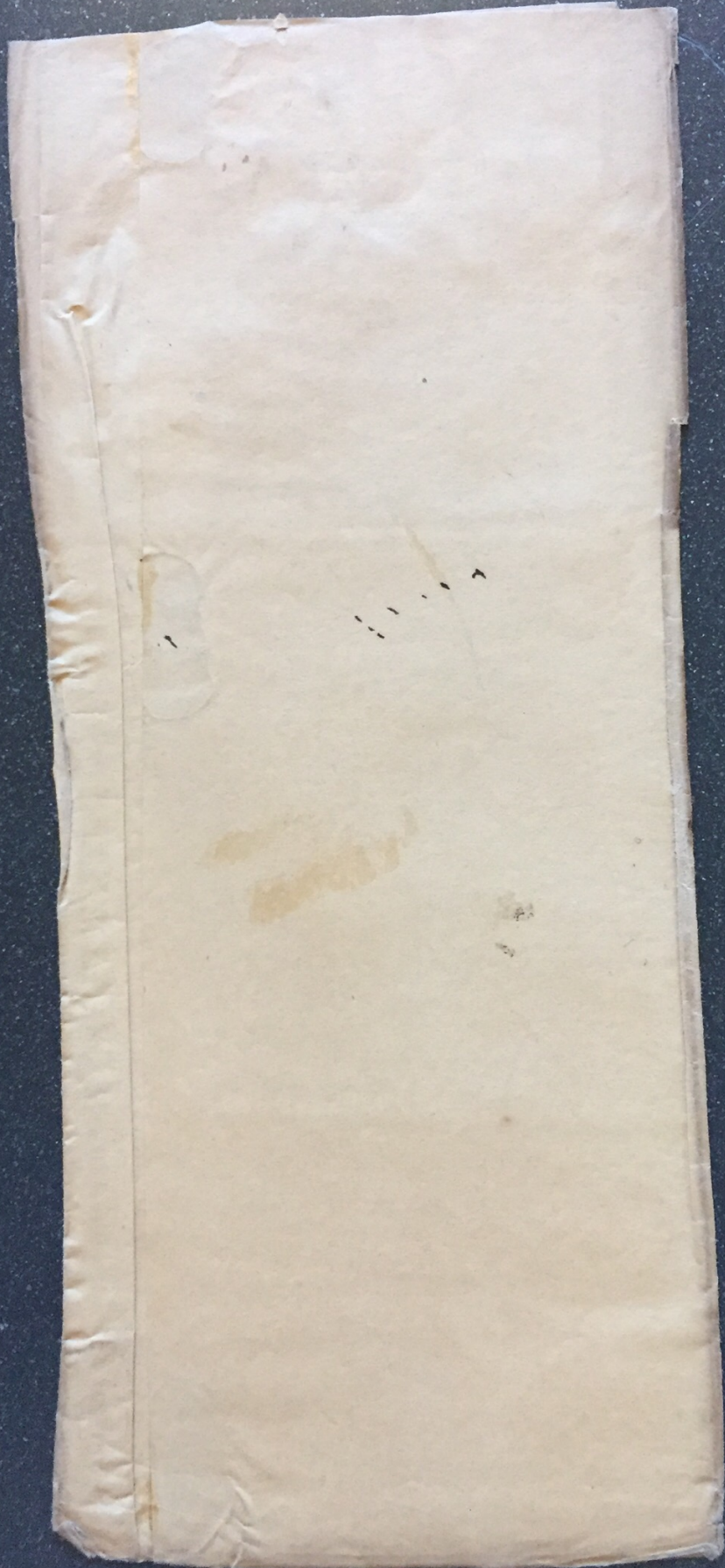

Kent aged *thirty seven* years, a resident of *Columbus*
in the State of *Georgia* who being duly sworn according to law, declares that
he is the identical *Harvin W Kent* who was a *Private Soldier*
in the Company of *Ryfan* commanded by Captain *Joseph*
Coleman in the *Regiment* commanded by *Colonel Hardiman*
in the War known as the War *Against the Creek*
Indians of 1836 that he has a substitute and was
mustered into the service of the United States at *Columbus* in the State of
Georgia on or about the *26th* day of *April*
A. D. one thousand eight hundred and *thirty six* for the term of
three months and continued in actual service in said War for the term of *about*
three months and was honorably discharged at *Columbus*
in the State of *Georgia* on or about the *15th* day of
July A. D. one thousand eight hundred and *thirty six*
Deponent *cannot distinctly recollect the date*
of his muster or discharge - He never
received a written discharge -

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the **Bounty Land** to which he may be entitled under the "Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military service of the United States," passed September 28th, 1850. Deponent has never received, and is not entitled to receive any Bounty Land, under any Act of Congress heretofore passed.
