claimed and by these presents do bargain, sell, remise and
quit claim unto the said Moses Fullington and to his heirs
and assigns, all our right title interest claim or demand to
the real estate of Silas Kent Dec^d late of the County
of Union and State of Ohio Together with all and singular the
hereditaments and appertinances therunto belonging or in any
wise appertaining, and the reversion, remainders, rents, issues
and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest
claim or demand whatsoever of us the said Hiram Kent and
Miranda his wife either in law or Equity, of in and to the
above bargained premises. To have and to hold the same unto
the said Moses Fullington his heirs and assigns forever
