the West half of the North East quarter of Section four in Township fifty five of Range twenty eight in the District of lands subject to sale at *Lewington Missouri* containing seventy five acres and seventy two hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Horatio N Kent*


