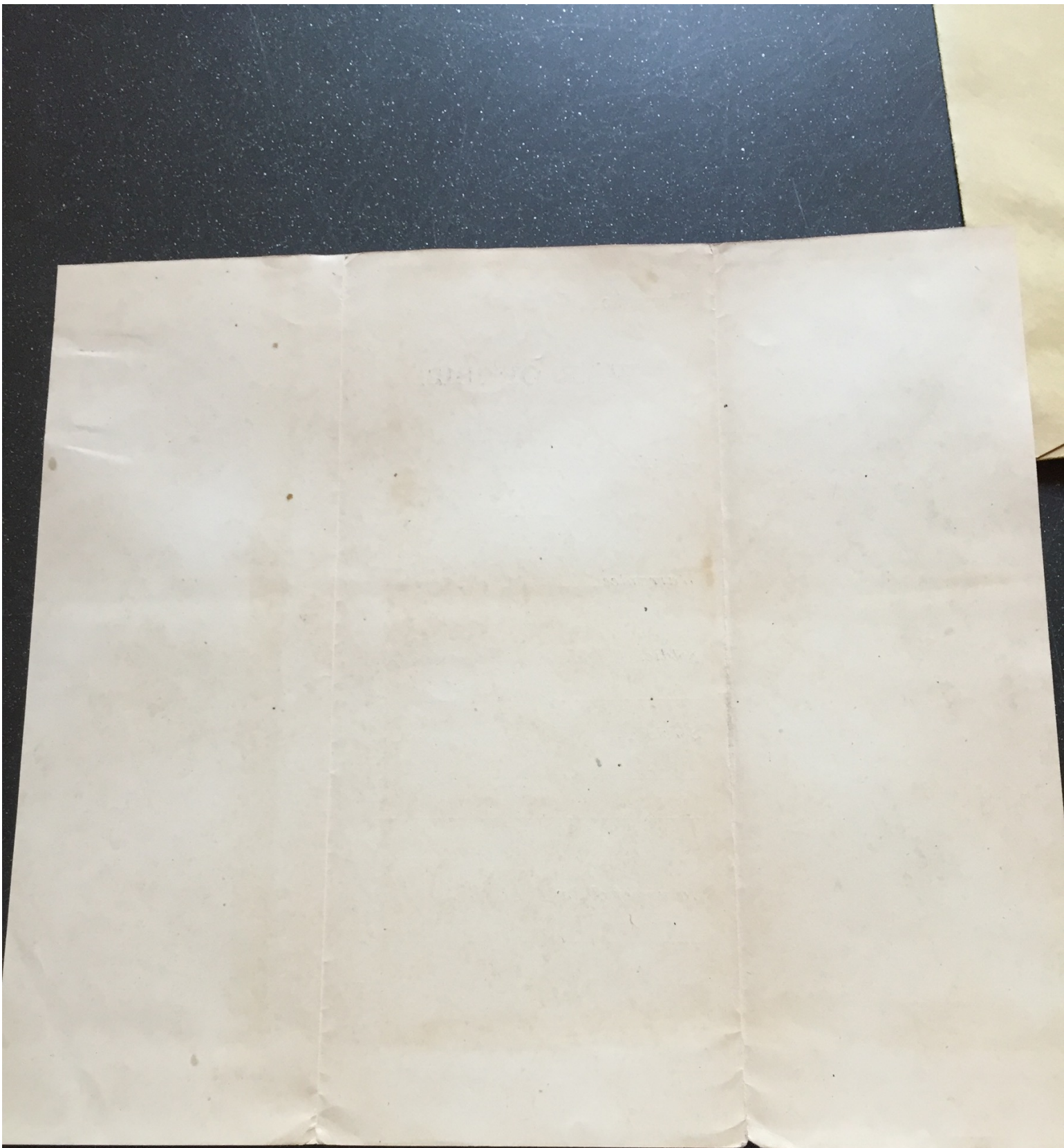

KNOW YE, That *Isaac Kent*, a private of Captain *Levi S. Ingersoll's* Company *Twenty Third* regiment of *Infantry* who was enlisted the *Fifth* day of *February* served out the full period of his enlistment.

Said *Isaac Kent* was born in the *County of Berkshire* of *State of Massachusetts* is about *twenty-two* years of age, *five* feet *Eight* inches high, *Light* complexion, *Blue* eyes, *Brown* hair, and by occupation, when enlisted, a *Farmer*.

Given at *Jack's Harbor New York* this *Fifth* day of *July* 1815.
