- In the War of 1812, he was a Lieutenant in the Virginia Militia from Wythe Co., Virginia under Capt. Samuel Graham. He then attached to Capt. Arthur Emmerson's Company.

# MILITARY BOUNTY LAND CLAIM.

WAR OF 1812.

STATE OF VIRGINIA, SS.

Montgomery County

On this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1855, before me Sam<sup>l</sup> A M<sup>c</sup>Conkey

a Justice of the Peace, in and for the State and County aforesaid, personally appeared Jacob Kent aged 64 years, and a resident of said County

who being duly sworn, declares he is the identical person who was a ~~Soldier~~ Lieutenant in the War of 1812, in the Company of Captain Sam<sup>l</sup> Graham from Wythe Co.

that he was afterwards attached to Capt Emmerson on or about the day of Oct 1813

for the term of ~~six~~ months, and continued in actual service for the period of six months, and was honorably discharged at Norfolk

about the day of ~~March~~, and that for said service he never received any BOUNTY ~~and~~ Land Warrant under the act of Congress, the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Sept or any other 1855 his commission he has now in his possession,

He makes this declaration in order to obtain the bounty land due him, under the act of Congress, passed the 2d day of March, 1855, and he hereby constitutes and appoints LAFAYETTE W. GRAY, of Lynchburg, his Attorney, to prosecute said claim.

Sworn to and subscribed the day and year above written, and I am perfectly satisfied the said Jacob Kent to be the identical person as represented above.

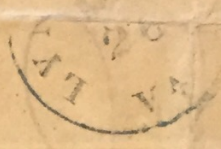

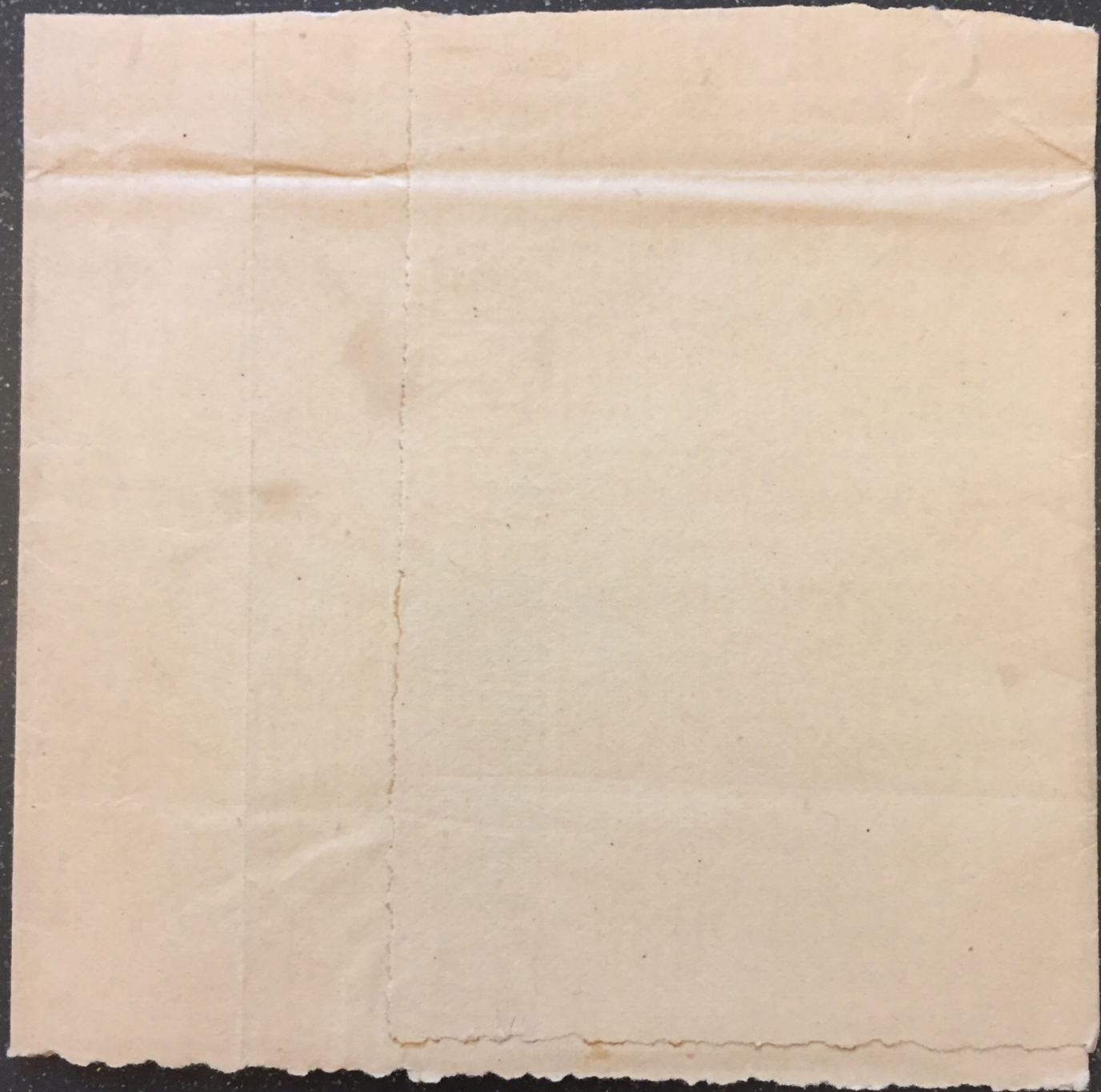


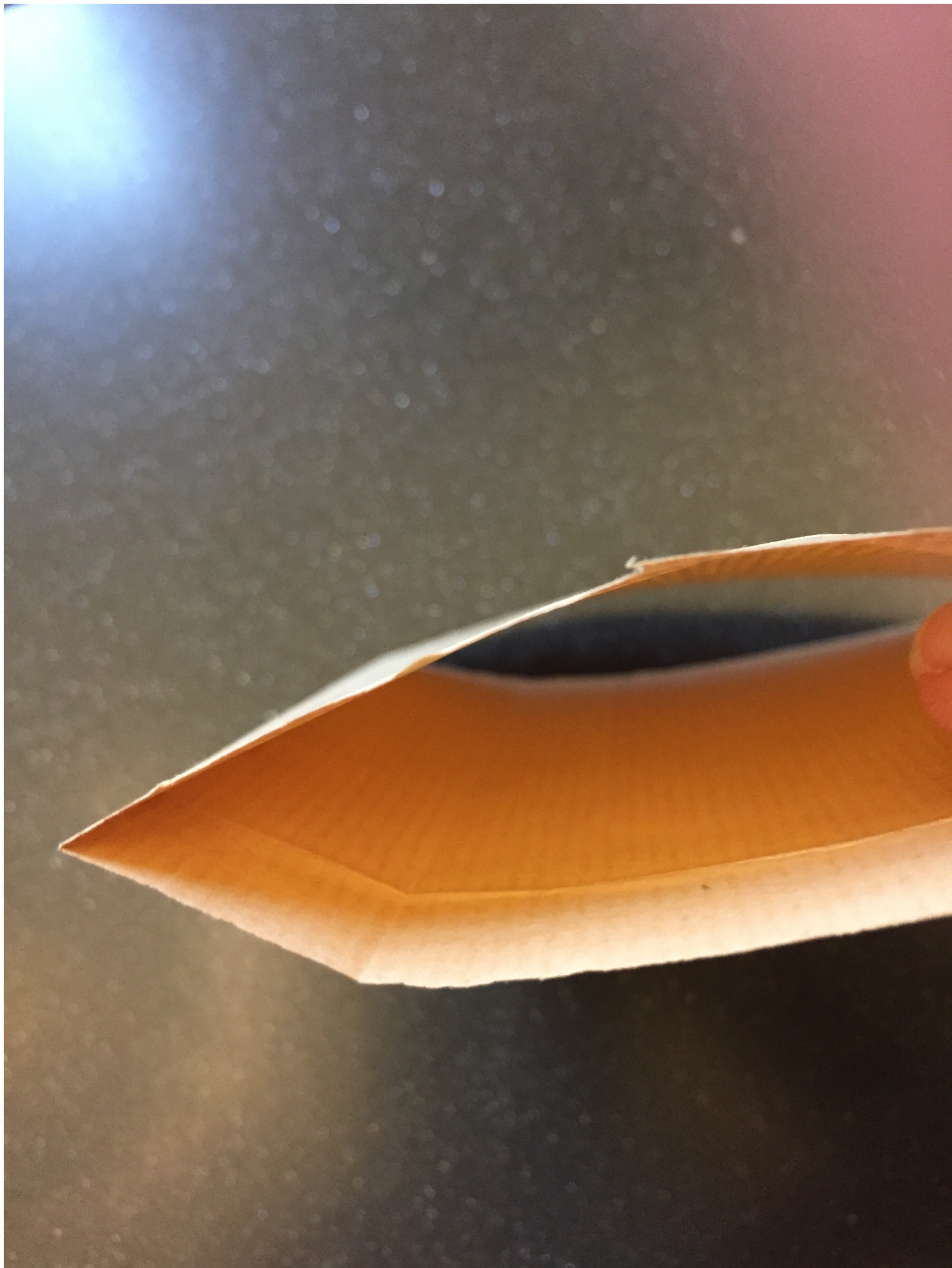
