Prine has been suspended; for for the cause that the
Captain ^{in name} under whom her husband James Kent
served, has not been given in her declaration &
she cannot give the name for in her application
for five years half pay she was unable to give
positively the name of any officers under whom
her deceased husband served to her proof
made by her before the County Court of Barry
County Missouri in the fall of the year 1849 I
self refer the department to however it appears
from the third Auditors report that her hus-
band James Kent in regard of whom she
claims bounty land served in the 3^d Infy
under Col Williams was wounded on
27th day of March 1814 and died the 28th
at the Battle of the Horse Shoos under Gene-
al Jackson 1814

me the undersigned clerk of the County
Court within and for the County of Mc-
Donald in the State of Missouri;
Obedience Paine who has heretofore duly
Proved her relationship in the County Court
of Barry County Missouri, by Elizabeth Paine,
and others, to James Kent, who was a
Soldier, of the 39th Infantry, was wounded
on the 27th of March, and ~~the~~ died
the 28th of March 1814, who being by
and duly sworn according to law, declares
that she is the widow of the said Kent,
and that ^{she} is the identical woman that
drew the sum of \$240, the being five
years pay allowed ^{her} as the widow of the
said Kent who died in the Army of United
States as aforesaid, Satisfactory Proof
may had by reference being to her papers
on the files of the Pension Office, in relation
to her marriage with her late husband
the above named James Kent. She makes
this declaration for the purpose of obtain-
-ing the bounty land to which she may
be entitled under the act passed Septem-
ber 28th A. D. 1850
