Came before me James Kent late a private of Captain
Sprowli's Company in the 13th Regiment of United States Infantry
and made oath that he enlisted as a soldier in the army of
the United States on the 11. day of May 1812, to serve 5 years,
and that he was honourably discharged from service on account
of disability at Greenbush by General A. Bimbeck the Commanding
Officer on the 26th April 1816. - and the said Kent further
saith that on his passage from Greenbush to New York on
the 13. day of May 1816. his hat blew off in a gale of
wind with his Papers, and totally lost them all among
which was his honorable discharge. This deponent
further states that he was discharged from Lieut. Drake's Detach-
ment ~~at Greenbush~~ in the 2d Regiment of In-

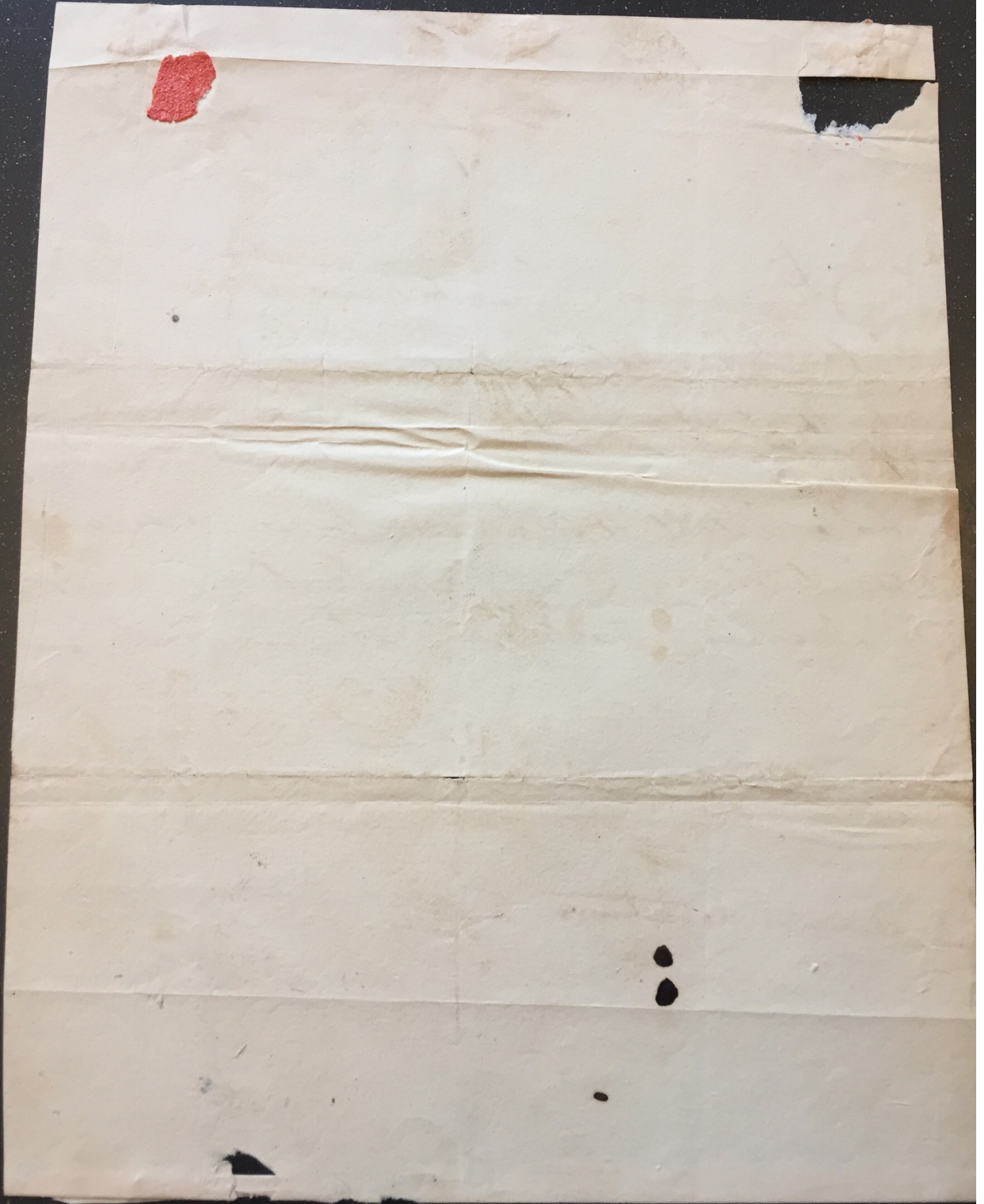

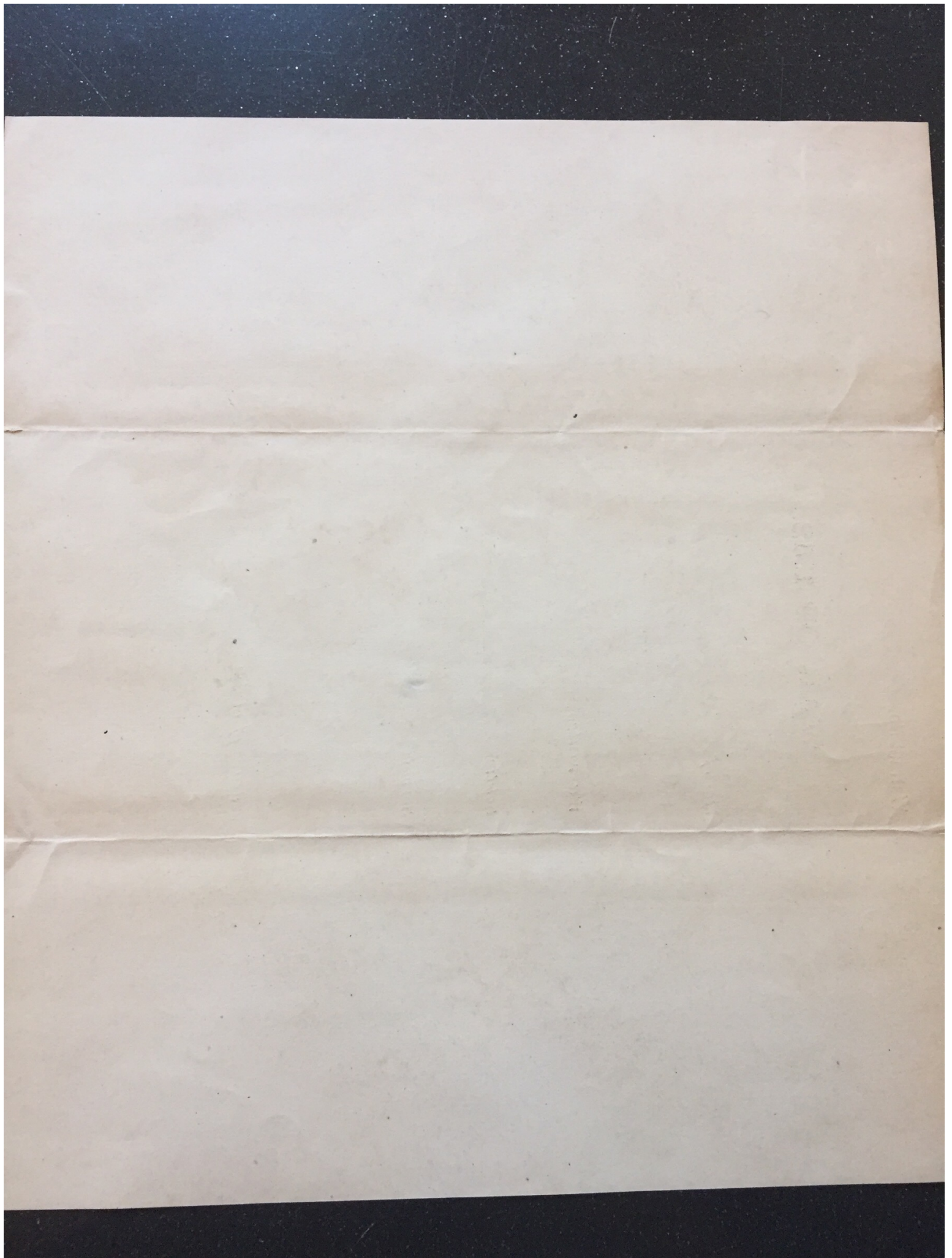

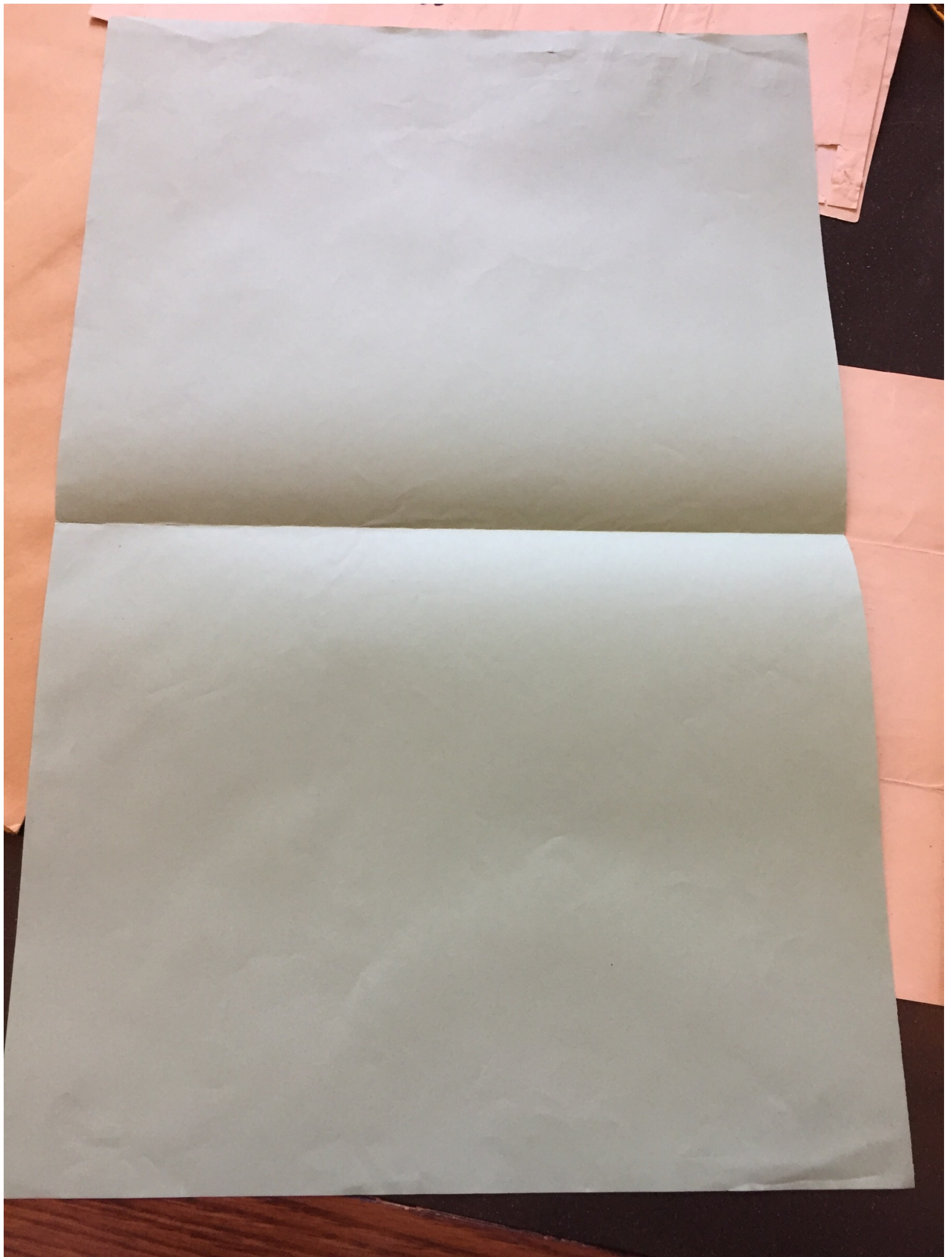
