day. Now Comes and Shows that John Kent died on
the 27th of October, 1853, and that at the time of his
death, it was believed by the undersigned and others of his
line that he did not testate. That during the life time
he transferred to the undersigned a considerable amount
of his Personal Property, that since his death a writing
supposed to be a will has been produced, and admitted
to Probate. Since which time a Bill in Chancery
has been filed under the statute, in order to set
aside said supposed will, which directly involves
the whole Estate, and will in the end settle all
matters of Controversy among the heirs and
claimants of the Estate of the said John Kent Decd.
That until said suit is determined it is impos-
sible to settle up the matters which are incident
to the Guardianship.

That it is believed that to Audi-
-re in a other Person, except those who have always
-attended, produced and set up the said supposed
will, and who expect an advantage by instituting
-this proc. in the pending litigation in another
Court, are harassing in this matter, and it is
-submitted that justice requires this matter to stand
-open until the pending litigation is determined

That we James Kent
William Swin and Benjamin Goodwater
are held and stand firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, in the penal sum of Five
Hundred dollars, to the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we do
hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these
presents; sealed with our seals, and dated this 29th day of August A. D. 1853.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, at a Court of Probate, holden
at the Office of the Probate Judge of said county, on the day aforesaid, James
Kent was appointed Guardian of the person of the property
of John Kent aged about Eighty
five years an imbecile old man
incapable to attend to his own business
child deceased.

Now, therefore, if the said James Kent shall discharge with fidelity
the trust reposed in him and render an accurate statement of his transactions,
with a just account of the profits arising and accruing from the real or personal estate of his
ward, and deliver up the same to the Court when thereunto required, then this obligation to be
void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.
