Recruits*, who was enlisted on the *thirtieth* day of *November* *during the war with Mexico* one thousand eight hundred and *forty seven* to serve ~~FIVE YEARS~~, is hereby HONORABLY DISCHARGED from the Army of the United States, this *twenty ninth* day of *June* 1848, at *Jefferson Barracks* *Missouri* by reason of *Expiration of term of service*
[No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.*]

Said *John Kent* was born in *Bavaria* in the State of *_____* is *twenty two* years of age, *five feet ten 1/4* inches high, *fair* complexion, *hazel* eyes, *brown* hair, and by occupation, when enlisted, a *Cooper*

GIVEN at *Jefferson Barracks mo* this *twenty ninth* day of *June* 1848.

*This sentence will be erased, should there be any thing in the conduct, or physical condition of the soldier, rendering him unfit for the Army.
