according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty four, of Township sixteen, North, of Range two, West of the third principal Meridian, in the District of Land subject to sale at Springfield, Illinois, containing forty acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said Josiah P. Kent

NOW KNOW YE, That the **United States of America**, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said Josiah P. Kent

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Josiah P. Kent and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, Martin Van Buren **PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these Letters to be made **PERTENT**, and the **SEAL** of the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
