


- On 20 December 1850, Nicholas Kent was age 65 (born about 1785) and a resident of Coshocton Co., Ohio.

He was drafted from Huntington, Pennsylvania in April 1814. [Note from MMR: There is a Huntingdon in Huntingdon Co., Pennsylvania and one in Adams Co., Pennsylvania.
Nicholas Kent signed with his mark.

On this twentiette day of december - St. D. 1850 PERSONALLY APPEARED, before me to boo to the tousing have a Justice of the Peace duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the County and State afcresaid Nicholas Kent - aged sixty fire years, a resident of Coshorton County - in the Ptate of Ohio, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Nicholas Kent who was a private - in the Company commanded by Captain _____ Morrows he dres not Reallest the mayor was manaded in the war with Great Britain declared by the United States June 18Th 1812 - that he was drafted at Aundington Perm on or about the Arriddle 2 of April of six months --- and continued in actual service in said war for the term of four months and was honorably discharged at Lake Eric, Penneyloania atmithe day of August Ob. D. 1814 (on account of there last being no farther needs of his services as will appear by The Rottes on file art He has lost his discharge if he had out washington City.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the Bounty Land to which he may be entitled under the "Obet granting bounty lands to certain Officers and Foldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," passed September 28th, 1859. Mehodar Meark

POWER OF ATTORNEY.

RIDU all Mea by these Presents, That <u>Aicholas Rent</u> of the County of <u>Costhoeton</u> and State of Ohio, have constituted and appointed, and by these presents do constitute and appoint <u>Kon</u>, <u>Moses Hoaglands</u> my true and lawful Attorney irrevocably for me and in my name to receive from the United States the Bounty Land Certificate or Warrant, or Pension Certificate, and all such sum or sums of money due me on account of arrears of pay, three months extra pay, or any money or moneys which may be due me from the United States on any account whatsoever, and generally to do all lawful acts and things whatsoever touching the premises, and an Attorney under him for the purposes aforesaid, to make and at his pleasure revoke, hereby confirming all and whatsoever mysaid attorney shall in my name legally do or cause to be done in and about the premises.
