ON THIS twenty ninth day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty five personally appeared before me James C. Edwards a Notary Public within and for the County and State aforesaid authorized under the laws of Georgia to administer oaths for general purposes

Price Kent aged sixty years, a resident of Twiggs County in the State of Georgia, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Price Kent

who was a ~~Drummer~~ Private Soldier in the company commanded by Captain William Lee in the Regiment of Georgia Troop, commanded by Colonel Daniel Newman

in the war with Great Britain declared by the United States on the 18 day of June 1776 - Went from Campthorpe to Fort Mitchell, Alabama, was at the battles of Lake & Calabee with the Creek Indians - in the state of Alabama

that said at Levellent on or about the _____ day of _____ A. D. for the term of Six months and continued in actual service in said war for the term of six months and was honorably discharged at Fort Hawkins Georgia on the _____ day of _____ A. D.

He further says he has applied for & obtained a Bounty Land warrant for 80 acres, the number of which he does not now recollect - that he has since legally disposed of the same & cannot now return it - he further says that he has never applied for nor received any other Bounty Land under any act of Congress except that above stated, which was under the act of September 28, 1850 -

he makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the Bounty Lands to which he may be entitled under the act of Congress approved March 3rd 1855,

and for which purpose he hereby appoints CLIFFORD ANDERSON of Macon, and said State, his true and lawful attorney for him and in his name place and stead, to ask, and receive from the proper officer of the United States Government the certificate or warrant for said Bounty Land; hereby ratifying what he does in the premises by virtue hereof.

On this *Twenty* day of *November* A. D. *1850*
one thousand eight hundred and *fifty* personally appeared before me, *James*
Pittman a *Justice of the Peace*, duly authorised to
administer oaths within and for the County and State, aforesaid, *Price Kent*
aged *fifty five* years, a resident of *Abbe County*, in the State of *Georgia*
who being duly sworn according to Law, declares that he is the identical *Price Kent*
who was a *Private* in the Company commanded by Captain *See*
in the *Volunteer* Regiment of *Georgia Militia* commanded by
Col. Newman in the war with *the Greek Indians of 1803*
under General Floyd


that he *has* been in at *Camp Hope* on or about the
day of *August* A. D. *1812* for the term
of *Six Months* and continued in actual service in said War for the term
of *Six Months* and was honorably discharged at *Fort Mifflin*
on the day of *February* A. D. *1814*
on account of *expiration of service* as will appear by *The Book*

Roll of his Regiment, by his discharge
being kept in his hand so that he cannot
produce it

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the Bounty Land to which he
may be entitled under the "act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who
have been engaged in the Military service of the United States," passed *28th Sept 1830*

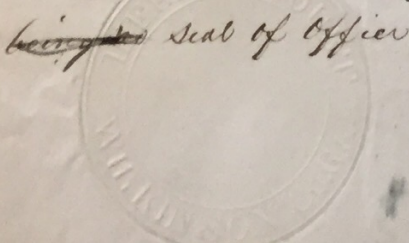

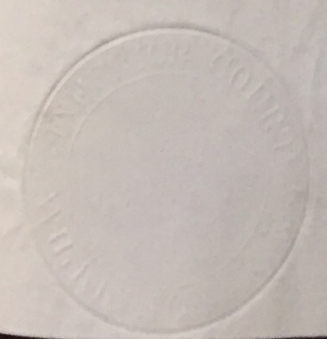
