• On or about 01 August 1864, Riley J. Kent contracted an illness and he subsequently died from that illness (it turned chronic) on 25 March 1865. Death occurred at the hospital in Cumberland Hospital, Nashville, Tennessee.

• Brother, Joseph Kent (of Crawford Co., Illinois) had a military pension, no. 52,082, and had an amputated arm from service. (He served in same company with this brother.)

• Joseph Kent (his brother) served within the same company.
