This Indenture made this 6th of November in the year 1827, between Robert Kent of the one part, and Jacob Kent of the other part: both of the County of Montgomery and State Virginia; Witnesseth that the said Robert Kent, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained, sold, Aliened and conveyed, and by these presents doth bargain, sell, alien and convey unto the said Jacob Kent his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred acres in the State of Ohio lying on Deer creek, and located by Cadwallader Wallace No 10507, the boundaries whereof are follows, to wit, Beginning at three bur oaks, corner to the heirs of Nicholas Hobsons Survey 6768; Thence with their line north one hundred and seventeen poles to four bur oaks, north-western corner of said Survey; Thence north five degrees west forty four poles to a stake in a prairie, fifty poles west of the south west corner of said Hobsons Survey No 6350 comes to the Representatives of William Andersons Survey No 8950; Thence with their line north thirty poles to three white oaks corner to their survey; Thence with another of their lines west two hundred and ninety three poles passing the south west corner of said survey at one hundred and twenty eight poles, to two white oaks, a northeasterly corner of said Hobsons No 6349; Thence south forty four degrees West, twenty four poles to two hickories and a black oak corner to said survey; Thence south forty six degrees East forty four poles to a white oak and black oak, comes to said survey; Thence south forty four degrees West seventy four poles, to three white oaks, corner to said survey in the line of William B. Harrison's Survey No 6151; Thence with said line south sixty one degrees east one hundred and sixty five poles to a bur oak and Elm northeast corner to said Survey in the line
