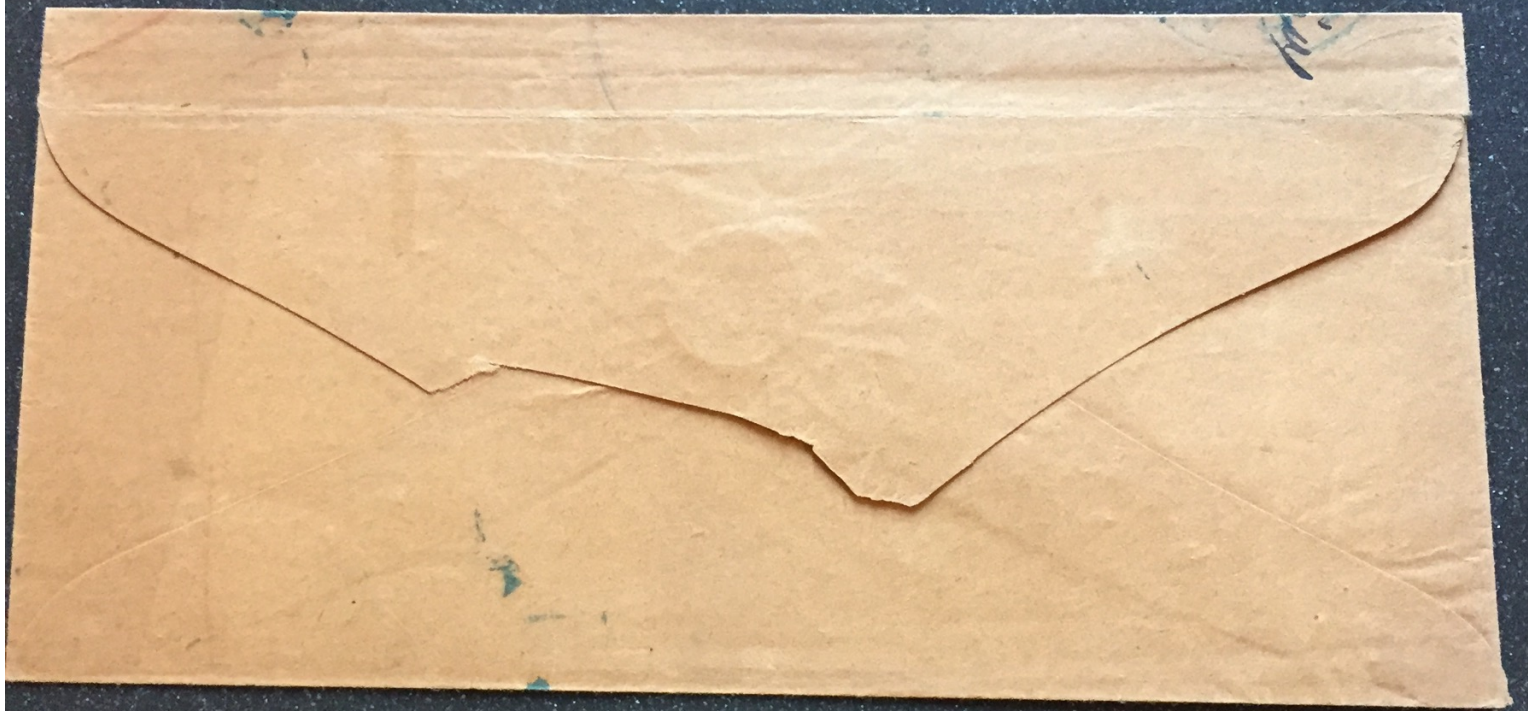

On this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January  
A D One thousand, eight, hundred, and fifty  
one, personally appeared before me a Justice of  
the Peace within and for the County and State  
aforesaid Robert Kent aged sixty four years  
a resident of the County and State aforesaid  
who being duly sworn according to law de-  
clares that he is the identical Robert Kent,  
who was a Sergeant, in the Company com-  
menced by Captain John Jones in the 2<sup>d</sup>  
Regiment, of Virginia Militia commanded  
by Col John B Locke in the war with  
Great Britain declared by the United States  
on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1812. That, he was  
drafted, at Fluvanna Court House on or about,  
the 24<sup>th</sup> day of March A D 1813 for the term  
of six months and continued in actual ser-  
vice in said war for the term five months  
lacking a few days and was honorably dis-  
charged at Camp Holly on or about, the 15<sup>th</sup>  
day of August, A D 1813, as will no doubt ap-  
pear by the muster rolls of said Company; his  
certificate of discharge was not obtained in  
consequence of being sick at the time.

He also declares that, he is the identical  
Robert Kent, who was an Ensign in the Com-  
pany commenced by Captain Thomas Sim-  
baker in the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment, of Virginia Mil-  
itia commanded by Col. William Gray in  
the war as above stated: That, he was drafted  
at Fluvanna Court House on or about the,

20<sup>th</sup> day of August, A D 1814, for the term  
of Six months and continued in actual  
Service in said war for the term of Six months  
and was honorably discharged at Camp  
Carter on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February A D 1815  
as will appear by his original Certificate  
of discharge herewith presented - making  
his whole term of actual Service near eleven  
months.

He makes this declaration for the  
purpose of obtaining the bounty land to  
which he may be entitled under the "Act  
granting bounty land to certain officers  
and soldiers who have been engaged in the  
military service of the United States" passed  
September 28<sup>th</sup> 1850. Robert Kent

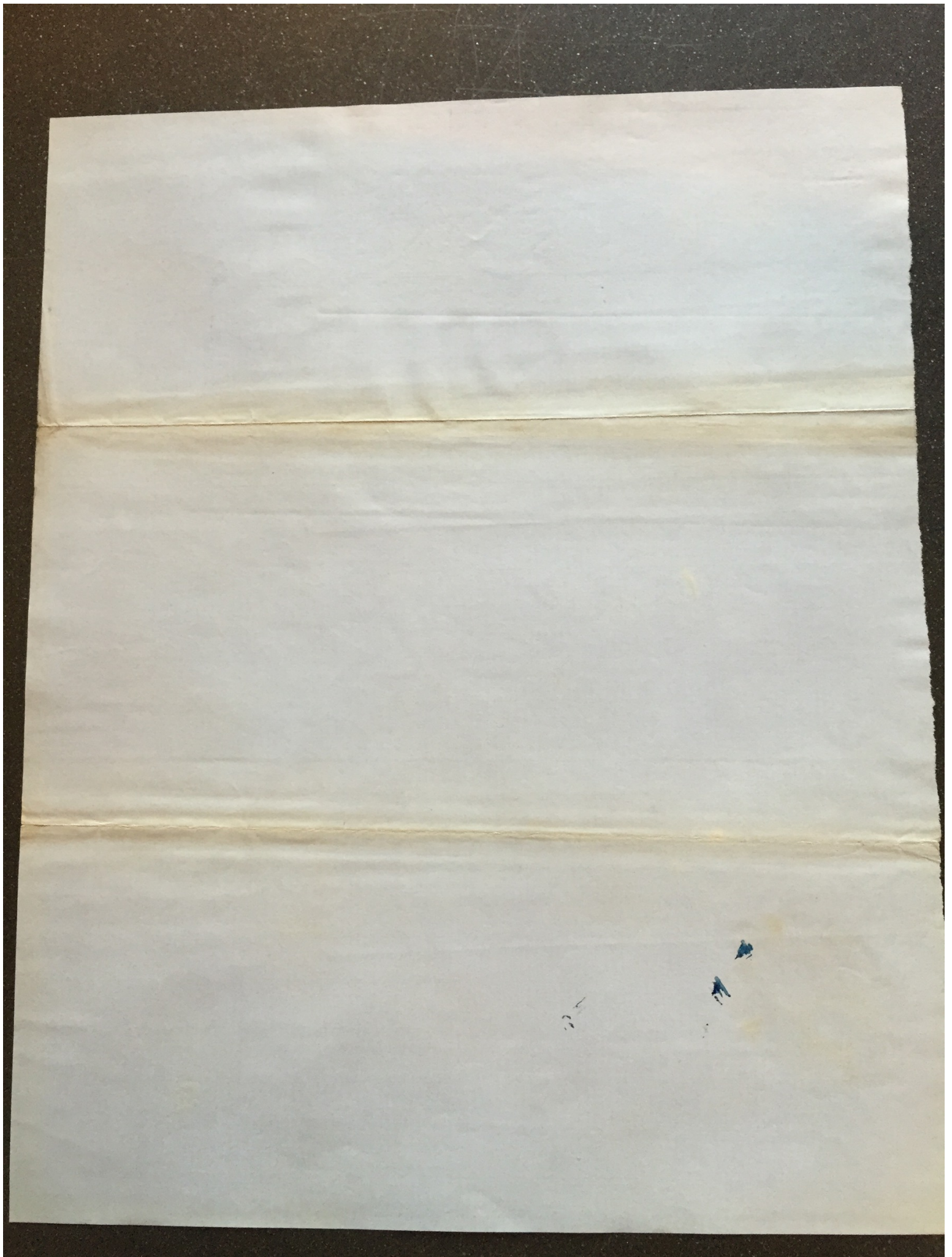

Louisee CH N<sup>o</sup> Dec. 5<sup>th</sup> 1861

Sir:

Yours of first Inst. informing me that the claim of Robert Kent, is suspended is to hand. He had a certificate for six months in Capt. Turnbull's company which was sent. By reference to the "Pay Rolls" copied from the Auditor's Office at Richmond published by act of the N<sup>o</sup> Legislature and first to hand I notice that Robert Kent served in Capt. Jones' company 3 months 26 days (he thinks he served longer) which added to the six months will make 9 mo. 26 days which would entitle him to 160 cens. I notice the man just above Robt. Kent, served 2 mo. 26 days which may be the figures you looked at in tracing out the names. Please refer to it again and if you can not satisfy me let me know & I will see R. K. about it.
