FORM OF DECLARATION FOR SURVIVING OFFICER OR SOLDIER.

State of Ohio, County of *Adams*, } SS.

On this *19th* day of *April*, A. D. one thousand eight hundred

and *fifty five*, personally appeared before me, ~~Thomas Keet~~ *J. Hamer*

a *Justice of the Peace*, duty authorized to administer oaths within and for
the *County* and State aforesaid, *Thomas Keet* aged *Seventy*
years, a resident of *Adams County* in the State of *Ohio* who being duly sworn

according to law, declares that he is the identical *Thomas Keet*

who was a *Corporal* in the Company commanded by Captain *Mathewe*
of the *State* in the *Third* Regiment of *Infantry* in *2nd Brigade 4th Division*
commanded by *Col. Thos Longly* in the war with *Great Britain* declared *June 18, 1812*

that he was drafted at *The County of Franklin State of Mass* on or about
the *first* of *September* A. D. *1814* for the

term of *Indefinite* and continued in actual service in said war for the term *(Boston*
of *Eight weeks* and was honorably discharged at *Commercial point 5 miles South of*
on the *Indefinite* of A. D. *1814*

on account of *The termination of the war*
as will appear by the muster rolls of said Company.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which he may be entitled under the "act
granting additional bounty land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United
States," approved March 3, 1855. And refers to his former declaration made under act of *Sept 28th 1850*

upon which he obtained a Land Warrant No. *not known* for *forty* acres, which he having
legally transferred and disposed of, is not in his power now to return.

He further declares that he has not received a warrant for bounty land under any other act of Congress, nor made
any application therefor, than the one above referred to. under act of *Sept 28, 1850* upon which he
obtained the said Land Warrant, No. *not known*, for *forty* acres, and the one now presented.
