 sell and convey unto Henry Fox and unto his heirs and
 assigns forever all my Right of Maintenance and forever
 quit Claim of and into the above named Land Described
 in Sterlings Deed to Stone as follows, Beginning at a walnut
 ash & Elm S Tr Corner to Frazerck. Thence N 80 E 176
 poles to a Sugar Beach & ash. Thence S 10 E 164 2/3 poles to
 two beeches & a Sugar Thence S 80 W 177 poles to three Beeches
 in the West line of the original Survey Thence N 10 West 164.6
 to the beginning containing 181 acres of land more or less &
 being part of Survey 2991 in the name of Phillips to have
 and to hold all interest & Claim to said Land that is vested
 in me by the above named James Stone will unto the said
 Henry Fox his heirs and assigns I do hereby forever quit
 Claim to said Land for Maintenance or other wise
 I Witness whereof the said Milly Stone hath hereunto set
 her hand and seal this 30th day of March 1849
